The Conductors

DR. NORBERT J. BUSKEY

Wind Ensemble

Dr. Buskey is the Director of Bands and instructor of saxophone at Syracuse University School of Music. He holds the B. S. and M. M. degrees from Ithaca College School of Music and has completed work towards the D. M. A. degree from the Eastman School of Music of the University of Rochester. He has a Performers Certificate in saxophone from the Eastman School of Music.

In addition to teaching in several New York State schools Prof. Buskey taught in Clarence, New York Central School system for seven years. While at Clarence he developed one of the finest high school wind ensembles in the Nation, and also instituted a commissioning program for new band compositions by American composers. Prior to his appointment to Syracuse University, Prof. Buskey was the conductor of the University of Rochester Symphony Band. In the summer of 1973 he established the band program at Chautauque Institute of Music, Chautauque, New York.

At Syracuse University, Prof. Buskey established the National Conducting Symposium with Pulitzer Prize Composer/Conductor Karel Husa. He also organized the New York State Band Symposium.

Prof. Buskey has served as an adjudicator, guest conductor, clinician, and soloist in the United States and Canada. He is a frequent guest conductor of All-State and Regional Bands. He was guest conductor of the 1977 MENC Division Conference Band in Washington, D.C. His lecture-demonstrations on "Rehearsal Techniques for the Band/Wind Ensemble" have been presented at high schools and colleges and at major music conferences.

DR. HARRY BEGIAN

Symphonic Band

Dr. Begian was named Director of Bands at the University of Illinois, Urbana campus, in 1970. Immediately prior to this appointment he was Director of Bands at Michigan State University for three years. Before his work at Michigan State he had been Director of Bands at Wayne State University, also for three years. Begian's band work at both of these universities earned for him the reputation he earned during his many years at Detroit's Cass Technical High School where he developed one of the finest high school bands in the country. During his last few years at Cass, Dr. Begian headed the Music and Performing Arts Departments.

Dr. Begian's musical training was in the public schools of Michigan where he was a private student of Leonard Smith, the well-known cornet and trumpet virtuoso. He received bachelor's and master's degrees at Wayne State University in Detroit, and later earned his doctoral degree at the University of Michigan.

Dr. Begian organized and conducted his first band and orchestra while in his late teens and has studied conducting at Tanglewood, summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. He has appeared as guest conductor, adjudicator, clinician and lecturer throughout the United States and Canada. Along with a very busy work schedule, he has found time to conduct operatic and Broadway performances, community symphony orchestras, community concert bands, and a church choir.

He is a recipient of the National Band Association Citation of Excellence and has recently established the University of Illinois Band Conductor Internship Program.

Dr. Begian was the guest conductor for the outstanding New Jersey All-State High School Band of 1966.

THE CONDUCTORS

H. ROBERT REYNOLDS
Wind Ensemble

H. Robert Reynolds is Director of Bands and Chairman of the Conducting Department at the University of Michigan. He has conducted in Orchestra Hall (Chicago), Avery Fisher Hall, Lincoln Center (New York), Kennedy Center (Washington, D. C.), Powell Symphony Hall (St. Louis), Alice Tully Hall, Lincoln Center (New York), Academy of Music (Philadelphia) and other distinguished concert halls. He has won the prize of composers Aaron Copland, Darius Milhaud, Gunther Schuller, Leslie Bassett, Karel Husa and many others for his interpretive conducting of their compositions, and each month he reviews the most recent band publications for THE INSTRUMENTALIST.

Professor Reynolds is an alumnus of The University of Michigan and holds degrees in Music Education and Wind Instruments. His teaching career began in Onsted (Michigan) Schools and continued at Anaheim (California) High School. He began his university conducting at California State University at Long Beach and received the Gold Award of Recognition from the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association. In 1968 He became the Director of Bands at The University of Wisconsin - Madison where he stayed until moving to the University of Michigan in 1975.

DONALD S. GEORGE
Symphonic Band

A 1948 graduate of Nutley, N. J. High School, Dr. Donald S. George is Director of Bands and Head of the Wind/ Percussion Division of the Music Department at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

Following college and military service, Dr. George taught music in Mountain Lakes and in Midland Park for 13 years. Completing his Doctorate in 1968, he left New Jersey joining the music faculty at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

Since 1968, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Band Program has grown to include over 250 students, comprising three, fully instrumented concert bands. A 120 piece marching band is made up of members of the three concert bands. Performances by the University Symphonic Band have received praise from conductors William D. Revelli, Frederick Fennell, Merle Evans, and Harry Beglion. Composers Norman Dello Joio, Karel Husa, Elie Siegmeister, and Robert Jager have praised the Symphonic Band for its interpretation of their compositions. The band has twice been selected for performance at the Wisconsin State Music Convention.

In 1979, Dr. George returned to New Jersey to direct the All North Jersey High School Wind Ensemble. While a New Jersey music educator he directed the All North Jersey Symphonic Band and Symphonic Orchestra. He also served as Treasurer of NJMEA 1961-65, President of NJSMA 1963-65, and was Eastern Division Chairman of NBA 1966-68.

The Conductors

The Conductor of the All State Wind Ensemble is **ROBERT F. ZELLNER**. Mr. Zellner is currently an Associate Professor of Music at Gettysburg College and director of bands since 1968. Prior to this, he taught instrumental music in the East Stroudsburg Area Schools. A graduate of West Chester University and Lehigh University, Mr. Zellner has also studied at Trenton State College and the University of Maryland. He has served the PMEA as well as the Phi Beta Mu, a National Bandmasters Fraternity. He has been very active in a number of professional associations both as a member and as an officer. In 1982 and 1983, he conducted the Pennsylvania All-State Lions Band. His achievements have been recognized by the National Federation of Music Clubs, the First Chair of America, the Silver Horn, Phi Beta Mu and the Cookie B. Shetter Memorial Award. Mr. Zellner is in constant demand as a conductor, adjudicator and clinician.



The conductor of the All State Symphonic Band is **EDWARD GOBRECHT**. Mr. Gobrecht is a native of Hanover, Pennsylvania and presently director of bands at Ithaca College, the position which he assumed in 1971 after the retirement of Walter Beeler. A graduate of Ithaca College and the Curtis Institute of Music, Mr. Gobrecht was a professional bassoonist with the New Orleans and Baltimore Symphonies. As a member of the 324th ASF Band during World War II, Mr. Gobrecht became actively interested in the field of teaching and professional playing. He has been quite active in the National Band Association, New York State Music Educators Association, MENC, Kappa Kappa Psi and Phi Mu Alpha. Since 1971, the Ithaca Band has made recordings for Golden Crest and Shawnee Press. Mr. Gobrecht is recognized as an outstanding clinician, adjudicator, performer and conductor.

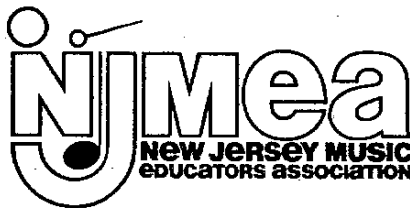

DON WILCOX

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Characterized by a sensitive interest in the preparation and training of young musicians, Don Wilcox has guided the development of the band program at West Virginia University to a position of national recognition. The seven active bands rehearsing and performing in the twelve million dollar Creative Arts Center provide West Virginia University students and the university community with over fifty performances each school year.

Each band is unique and they range in size from over three hundred thirty members in the "Pride of West Virginia" Marching Band, to a forty-five piece Wind Ensemble which has performed for national conferences of both the MENC and CBDNA, and represented the United States in 1981 at the first International Conference for Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles in Manchester, England. The Symphonic Band, Concert Band, Varsity Band, and two Jazz Ensembles all function independently to provide a wide range of performance opportunities and experiences for students and appropriate performing groups for diverse audiences.

Following graduation from the University of Michigan and eight years of public school instrumental music, Mr. Wilcox directed outstanding university band programs in California and Kansas before coming to West Virginia University in 1971. He is active in numerous professional organizations, and has received several significant awards for professional accomplishments and service to the University and the state of West Virginia.

Working with musicians of all ages and abilities. Mr. Wilcox has conducted bands in more than thirty states, Mexico, Canada, and England, including summer music camps for the University of Michigan, University of Wisconsin, University of Illinois, University of Georgia, University of Arkansas and at Interlochen, Michigan. His work with all-state bands, festival and honor groups has led to an active schedule throughout the nation as a clinician and guest conductor.

EMERY L. FEARS

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Emery L. Fears is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Norfolk State University, Norfolk, Virginia. He is a graduate of Howard University and the University of Michigan.

His work with the Norcom and Manor high school bands, Portsmouth, Virginia, enable them to earn eighteen consecutive Division One (I) ratings in festivals, most of them in the most difficult category for high school bands.

His University Symphonic Wind Ensemble has performed in nine states and the District of Columbia, notably for the Southern Division, College Band Directors National Association's Conference (Charleston, South Carolina) and the All-Eastern Band and Instrumental Clinic (School of Music, Naval Amphibious Base, Norfolk, Virginia).

The Norfolk State University "Spartan Legion" Marching Band has been featured on the NCAA Game of the Week, the Christian Broadcasting Network's "700" Club, and on the nationally syndicated show, P.M. Magazine.

Mr. Fears has served as an adjudicator, clinician and conductor in several states. He is a charter member of the National Band Association, and is currently serving on its Board of Directors. He is Past President of the South Division of the college Band Directors National Association, and is a member of the Flag of Honor Committee for outstanding high school bands of the John Philip Sousa Foundation. Mr. Fears was featured in the SCHOOL MUSICIAN, DIRECTOR AND TEACHER magazine's "Making America Musical" series honoring musicians who are making outstanding contributions to music education (1983-1984). He has served as clinician/consultant for the Norfolk (Virginia) Public Schools, and is an adjudicator for International Music Festivals, Inc.

In addition to membership in the CBDNA and NBA, Mr. Fears is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, the Music Educators National Conference, and the Virginia Band and Orchestra Association. He has been awarded the NBA "Citation of Excellence," and is listed in the **Directory of Distinguished Americans** and the **International Who's Who of Musicians**.

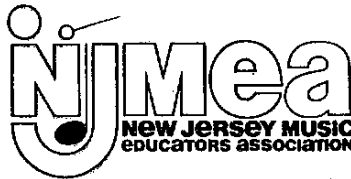

FRANCIS W. MCBETH
Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Francis W. McBeth is Professor of Music, Resident Composer and Chairman of the Theory-Composition Department at Ouachita University (pronounced wash-i-law) in Arkadelphia, Arkansas, and has held this position since 1957. Dr. McBeth was appointed to the Lena Trimble Shepperson Endowed Choir of Music by the president and trustees of Ouachita University in 1963. He was conductor of the Arkansas Symphony Orchestra in Little Rock for many years until his retirement in 1973, whereupon he was elected Conductor Emeritus in honor of his work with this professional orchestra.

He has received an ASCAP Special Award each consecutive year from 1965 to the present, the ASBDA Edwin Franko Goldman Award in 1963, and the Howard Hanson Prize at the Eastman School of Music for his Third Symphony in 1963. In January 1975, McBeth was appointed Composer Laureate of the State of Arkansas by the Governor.

McBeth's formal training was received at Hardin-Simmons University, University of Texas and the Eastman School of Music. His publications include works of all media: choral, chamber, orchestral and band. His intense interest in the wind symphony has been a shaping force in its literature, and his style is much reflected in the younger composers.

As a composer, he has consistently been in the top group of the most performed American symphonic wind composers during the past twenty years, and as a conductor and lecturer, he travels nine months of the year and has conducted in 46 of the 50 states, Canada and Japan.

WARREN S. MERCER
Conductor, Symphonic Band

Warren S. Mercer is director of bands for the North Hills School District where he has taught for the past 26 years. A graduate of Carnegie-Mellon University, he has done graduate work at Carnegie-Mellon University, Duquesne University, and the University of Michigan.

Mr. Mercer is the recipient of the "Citation of Excellence" presented by the National Band Association for outstanding contributions to bands and band music. A member of PMEA and MENC, he was elected to membership in the prestigious American Bandmasters Association in 1972. He is also a member of the John Philip Sousa Foundation Selection Committee.

Mr. Mercer has served as adjudicator in Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Ohio, Maryland, and the Florida All-State Music Contests. He has served as guest conductor for numerous honors bands, district, region and All-State Bands. He has been director of the Carnegie-Mellon University Wind Ensemble, Kiltie Marching Band and the Duquesne University Symphony Band.

His bands have made appearances for the following conventions: MENC National Conference; PMEA State Conference; MENC Divisional Conferences; Mid-West National Band Clinic; All Eastern Instrumental Clinic; and the Mid-East Instrumental Clinic.

The North Hills Symphony Band has the longest continuous commissioning series in the country. To date, 27 works have been commissioned for concert band during the past 22 years. The Symphony Band is also the only high school to press a record for Crest Records Authenticated Composer Series.

RICHARD CASTIGLIONE is currently Chairman of the Music Division at The Boston Conservatory and Director of The Boston Conservatory Summer Institute. At The Boston Conservatory, he has conducted the Symphonic Wind Ensemble and is presently conductor of The Boston Conservatory Orchestra. Mr. Castiglione started his early music studies with his father in solfeggio, conducting and trumpet. He has earned the degrees of Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts in Music and Music Education. Additional studies include trumpet with Ernest Williams and counterpoint with Charles O'Neil. Mr. Castiglione has been instrumental director in the New York and Connecticut public schools and was Supervisor of Music for the Philadelphia Public Schools. He was the former Dean at the Philadelphia Musical Academy and the President and Director of the Amherst Summer Music Center. Other conducting positions have been held by Mr. Castiglione at the Manhattan School of Music, the Philadelphia Musical Academy and Boston University. He is also very active as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States. As a professional trumpet player and conductor, his credits include all the radio and TV networks in New York City performing on the Jackie Gleason, Kate Smith, Jack Paar Shows and the orchestras of NBC and CBS as well as Musical Director for the Arlene Francis Show, Steve Lawrence and Edyie Gorme, Polly Bergen and Giselle McKenzie. His recordings include RCA Victor, Columbia and MGM records. Mr. Castiglione is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and Pi Kappa Lambda, and he is the recipient of the MENC Excellence in Performance Award.

WALTER CHESNUT has been a Professor of Music at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst since 1967. Active as an educator, performer and conductor, he teaches all applied trumpet courses at the University. Professor Chesnut began his career at the University of Michigan where he received both his Bachelor and Master of Music and was soloist with the University Symphony Band. From 1959-62, he was school-wide band director in Colon, Michigan and from 1962-66 was junior high band director and orchestra director in Sturgis, Michigan. His ensembles were consistent first division winners in district and state competitions, and his reputation as clinician, soloist and adjudicator became widely known in the Midwest.

After coming to the University of Massachusetts, Professor Chesnut founded the Brass Choir and has been its conductor from 1970-77 and again from 1979 to 1984. He directed the Brass Choir on a Romanian tour in 1976 and at a special appearance before the Eastern Division of MENC. He was director of the Amherst-Mount Holyoke Orchestra in 1973-74. More recently, Mr. Chesnut has conducted the All-Eastern Band, in conjunction with the Eastern Division In-Service meeting in Boston in 1983. He has conducted the All-New England Band, as well as five All-State Bands. Professor Chesnut has been a member of seven symphony orchestras and was principal trumpet in the Springfield (Massachusetts) Symphony Orchestra from 1967-73. Highlights of his many appearances as a guest soloist include European tours with the University Chorale in 1970, with the Worcester Polytechnical Institute Glee Club in 1975. He has toured the eastern United States with several organists, performing Baroque trumpet literature. His recently released recording for trumpet and organ is available on the AFKA label, and his second and third recordings will available soon on the same label.

MANUEL ALVAREZ

Conductor, Wind Ensemble

Manuel Alvarez is currently Interim Dean at the University of Hartford's Hartt School of Music and Music Director and Conductor of the Hartt Symphony Orchestra. He received a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music and Master's and Doctoral degrees from SUNY at Buffalo.

Dr. Alvarez has prepared orchestras for Yehudi Menuhin and the Beethoven Society, Leland Chen and the 1986 Kennedy Center Honors, as well as for composers Gunther Schuller and Henry Brant. He has conducted critically-acclaimed opera performances of Britten's *The Rape of Lucretia* and Stravinsky's *The Rake's Progress* for the Hartt Opera/Music Theater. In 1989, he will conduct Mozart's *Così fan tutte*, and the Hartt Symphony Orchestra with pianist Jeremy Menuhin in an all-Beethoven program at Tully Hall. Additional conducting credits include the Manchester Symphony, Niagra Falls Philharmonic, Chektowaga Symphony, and Hartt Symphonic Wind Ensemble.

Dr. Alvarez has performed trumpet with the Eastman Wind Ensemble, Buffalo and Rochester Philharmonic Orchestras, Buffalo Philharmonic Brass Quintet, and has recorded for Nonesuch, Turnabout, Mercury, and CBS records. He is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda and appears frequently as a guest conductor and clinician.

FRANK B. WICKES

Conductor, Symphonic Band

Frank B. Wickes, director of bands at LSU since 1980, received his degrees from the University of Delaware and the University of Michigan. He taught in public school band programs in Delaware and Virginia for thirteen years and served as director of bands at the University of Florida from 1973 until 1980.

At LSU, Wickes is responsible for administering the total band program. He conducts the Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band, directs the Tiger Marching Band, and teaches conducting and wind literature courses. He is highly active as a clinician, having served as guest conductor and adjudicator throughout the United States and Canada. He is currently president of the National Band Association and is an active member of the College Band Directors National Association, the American Bandmasters Association, the Music Educators National Conference, and the World Association of Symphonic Band and Ensembles.
