Dr. Adam Glaser - Conductor of the Orchestra



Adam Glaser is the Music Director of the professional-caliber Juilliard Pre-College Orchestras and Director of Orchestras and Associate Professor of Music at Hofstra University. In 2023, he begins his tenure as Music Director and Conductor of Long Island's renowned South Shore Symphony.

Recent engagements include the New Jersey Symphony, where Glaser filled in last-minute for Music Director Xian Zhang. Previous posts and engagements include Principal Conductor of the NYU Orchestras and the Usdan Center for the Arts, a nine-concert residency with the Symphonia Boca Raton, performances with the orchestras of Wheeling, Illinois and Victoria (British Columbia), and collabora-

tions with such distinguished artists as Itzhak Perlman, Joyce Yang, Conrad Tao, Vijay Gupta, Timo Andres, Monica Yunus and Areta Zhulla. Notable conservatory and youth orchestra engagements include the Interlochen Philharmonic, Purchase Symphony Orchestra, All-Eastern Honors Orchestra and multiple All-State Honors Orchestras. Selected awards include the American-Austrian Foundation's Karajan Fellowship for Young Conductors. Earlier in his career, Glaser was selected as a finalist for assistant conductor positions at the Philadelphia Orchestra and the Seattle Symphony.

An established composer, Glaser's works have been performed by over 30 orchestras throughout the U.S. and Canada, including the orchestras of Philadelphia, St. Louis, Baltimore, Atlanta, Milwaukee, Utah, Vancouver, Illinois and Toronto. Commissions include his *Passacaglia* for string orchestra, *Launch* for orchestra and chorus, and an arrangement of *Hatikvah* for string orchestra and children's chorus.

Glaser opera credits include his New York City Opera debut conducting the world premiere of Ted Rosenthal's *Dear Erich*, *La Tragédie de Carmen* (Bizet/Constant) with Curtis Opera Theater, Purcell's *Dido and Aeneas*, Gluck's *L'Ivrogne Corrige* and Schubert's *Die Verschworenen* with Hofstra Opera Theater, and Mozart's *Bastien und Bastienne* with Ridotto Opera Theater. At the Usdan Center for the Arts, he led several multi-disciplinary performances including a collaboration with the Usdan Center's ballet company, chorus, vocal soloists and orchestra in selections from Orff's *Carmina Burana*.

An active jazz pianist, composer and recording artist, Glaser released his debut CD, *Wide Awake*, with the Adam Glaser Trio in 2019, and followed in 2021 with a solo album, *Excursions*. As a founding member of Phil Orch Jazz, Glaser has performed and toured with this unique group of Philadelphia Orchestra musicians, appearing at such venues as World Cafe Live and the Kimmel Center's Commonwealth Stage in Philadelphia, the Kaplan Penthouse at Lincoln Center in New York, and the Bravo! Vail Music Festival in Colorado. He has collaborated with groups ranging from the bluegrass-inspired DePue Brothers to world-music/fusion group Batik.

Profoundly committed to arts education and community engagement, Glaser is the creator and host of The Composer's Paintbrush, a series in which he leads audiences through an exploration of the creative techniques behind musical masterworks.

Glaser earned graduate degrees in orchestral conducting from the Curtis Institute of Music and the University of Michigan, an MBA from the Ross School of Business (University of Michigan), a BA from the University of Pennsylvania in English, Afro-American Studies and Music, and a diploma in composition from the Juilliard Pre-College Division. His primary conducting teachers include Otto-Werner Mueller and Kenneth Kiesler, and his master class teachers include Christoph Eschenbach, Helmut Rilling and Gianluigi Gelmetti.

Dr. Marques L.A. Garrett - Conductor of the Chorus



A Virginia native, Marques L. A. Garrett (he/him) is Associate Professor of Choral Studies at the University of North Texas. His responsibilities include conducting the University Singers and teaching graduate and undergraduate choral conducting. His previous appointments were at the University of Nebraska–Lincoln and Cheyney University. Additionally, he holds a PhD in Music Education (Choral Conducting) from Florida State University, an MM from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, and a BA from Hampton University.

An active conductor, Dr. Garrett is the founding conductor of the Nebraska Festival Singers and previously served as artistic director of the Omaha Symphonic Chorus. He serves as a guest conductor or clinician with school, church, and community choirs throughout the country in addition to festival and honor choirs in Georgia, Kansas, Massachusetts, Michigan, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Virginia. His most recent engagements were with the NAFME All-Northwest and Connecticut All-State Mixed Choirs. Aside from his conducting classes at UNT, he leads conducting workshops at other universities and conferences. His formal conducting studies were with Dr. André J. Thomas, Dr. Carole J. Ott, Dr. Carl G. Harris, Jr., and Mr. Royzell Dillard.

A versatile voice that performs both as a baritone and countertenor, Dr. Garrett has sung with several community, church, and university groups as both a chorister and soloist. He was the baritone soloist for the Germantown Concert Chorus's performance of Haydn's *Missa in Angustiis*. His premiere as a countertenor in Dan Forrest's *Jubilate Deo* served as the work's European premiere in Limerick, Ireland. Additionally, he performed the role of Lil Lud in Bernstein's *White House Cantata* with the Tallahassee Community Chorus. Currently, he sings with the Festival Singers of Florida and Jason Max Ferdinand Singers.

Dr. Garrett is an avid composer of choral and solo-vocal music whose compositions have been performed to acclaim by high school all-state, collegiate, and professional choirs including Seraphic Fire, the Oakwood University Aeolians, and the National Lutheran Choir. His music is available through more than ten publishers. He has been commissioned by the Cincinnati Youth Choir, Concordia Choir, Harvard University, Mendelssohn Chorus of Philadelphia, and Westminster Choir College. Among his latest commissions is his largest work to date, *Dreamland: Tulsa 1921*. This collaborative work with librettist Sandra Seaton for tenor-bass chorus, soloists, and chamber orchestra was commissioned by the Turtle Creek Chorale to tell the story of the Greenwood district of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

As a researcher, his most advantageous topic is the non-idiomatic choral music of Black composers. His lectures at state and regional conferences of the American Choral Directors Association and at other local and national venues afford him the opportunity to showcase this underrepresented area of music resulting in the anthology *The Oxford Book of Choral Music by Black Composers* released in February 2023. His peer-reviewed presentations and headlining events for conferences and organizations have been in Alabama, Arkansas, Delaware, Florida, Kansas, Iowa, Maine, Michigan, North Dakota, South Dakota, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and Canada. He serves as co-editor of the "Out from the Shadows" Series with Gentry Publications.

Dr. Garrett holds membership in the American Choral Directors Association; American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers; National Association of Negro Musicians; National Collegiate Choral Organization; and Pi Kappa Lambda. For more information, visit www.mlag-music.com.

Msifuni Mungu!

Jarrett Roseborough

This is a celebratory piece about a greater deity/ruler God who has done great things for humanity. This piece can be understood not just to represent a spiritual deity but also a life's purpose that is worth celebrating. This celebration calls for the entire body to be involved. The words, movements, claps, stomps, etc., are all expressions to lend to the fact that life, spirituality, and greater purpose are ideas worth celebrating.

All Night I Could Not Sleep

Laurel Luke Christensen

Thumbing through Jane Hirshfield's anthology of sacred poetry by women, I was immediately drawn to this short poem, attributed to Jin Dynasty poetess, Tzū-Yeh. Having inherited middle-of-the-night insomnia from my mother and passed it down to two wakeful little boys, I, like the poet, am well-acquainted with sleepless nights. The witching hour can magnify anxiety about the state of the world, the possibility of impending tragedy, and personal struggles. But occasionally, a stubborn hope also thrives in the dark. This "thing with feathers - / that perches in the soul," as Emily Dickinson called it, can clash with our inner pragmatists as we drift in and out of consciousness. The head and the heart, the cynic and the dreamer, the independent and the lover (perhaps the poet's story), and the artist ready to call it quits versus the one who keeps creating—all are more susceptible to mystical voices when removed from daylight distractions. I'm often attracted to art that depicts simultaneous conflicting emotions, a state of mind I highlighted musically with undulating lines, aleatory, dissonance, and mixed meter in alternating sections of dreaminess and alertness. Led by the poet's cryptic answer, this setting culminates in a tense, but clear, declaration that hope has won the night. *(notes from the composer)*

Cum Sancto Spiritu

José Mauricio Nunes Garcia

José Mauricio Nunes Garcia was an Afro-Brazilian composer, organist, and priest of the Classical era of music history. He is one of the most important Brazilian composers. His output of sacred music for the Catholic churches ranges from small hymns to large-scale masses including multiple requiems. "Cum Sancto Spiritu" is the final movement of a missa brevis (short mass) for choir, solos, 2 clarinets, 2 horns, and strings. In the characteristic style of the time period, there is much lightness and bounce to the song.

Can We Sing the Darkness to Light?

Kyle Peterson

The text invites the listener to imagine a world without weapons or war—where the human experience is defined not through continued judgment of others, but through the lens of mercy and compassion. It could be beautiful. *(notes from the composer)*

I wrote TaReKiTa as a gift for a choir called Urban Voices Project. They are a choir of people who are currently or have recently experienced homelessness on Skid Row in Los Angeles. They are so dear to me, and one day I just decided to teach them about Indian rhythm. They enjoyed the lesson so much that I wanted to write them a piece that would use what I had taught them. The result was TaReKiTa – I literally wrote it in an hour, just in a single moment of inspiration, and recorded myself singing all the parts for them to learn. It has since become a staple of their repertoire, but it's also been sung by so many choirs around the world. There is just something about the piece, perhaps borne out of my love for this choir, that just seems to resonate with people.

Practically speaking, this piece is based on sounds the Indian drum, the tabla, makes, called “bols” — they are onomatopoeic sounds that imitate the sound of the drum. The result is something like a scat would be in jazz – ecstatic, energetic, rhythmic music that feels good on the tongue.

When Thunder Comes

Mari Isabel Valverde

“When Thunder Comes” is a celebration of American civil rights heroes: Sylvia Méndez, who challenged California’s justice system in a fight for racial desegregation of schools; Helen Zia, Chinese-American lesbian feminist author, journalist, Fulbright scholar, and activist for peace; Harvey Milk, the first openly gay elected official in California’s history, remembered as a vocal gay rights advocate; and Freedom Summer’s “soldiers,” who risked their lives in their movement to enfranchise black voters in Mississippi of the 1960’s.

Calling attention to our history’s systemic erasure of the stories of marginalized human beings in the United States, Lewis’ sonnet presents a powerful model for patriotism. The drums, a figurative representation of a grass roots revolution, provide thunder, and the singing relays the message that, once unified, our individual voices can come together and “drown out fear.”

Soon I Will Be Done

Negro Spiritual, arr. Marques L.A. Garrett

This spiritual is about life after death. The hope of “no more weeping and a-wailing” and seeing loved ones who have passed on is the ever-present joy which drives the rhythmic energy of this arrangement. In the midst of a painful life with no assurance of freedom, this spiritual expresses the joy of living with God.

Lift Every Voice and Sing

J. Rosamond Johnson, arr. Roland M. Carter

This classic arrangement of what has been referred to as the “Black National Anthem” by the NAACP was inspired by Wilhousky’s arrangement of *The Battle Hymn of the Republic*. The original song began as a poem written by Johnson’s brother to celebrate Abraham Lincoln’s birthday. This arrangement was written for the Hampton Institute (now University) Choirs to begin their concerts with the audience singing the first verse. The choir would then march to the front of the performance space during the second verse. The final verse begins with an unaccompanied prayer followed by a jubilant, high-energy ending.
